

1. Join online

• Press Join online link



You need to apply online via your UKCP account.

Sign in as a Returning Visitor using your email address as a Username and a password which you have created. If you have forgotten your password, your password can be reset. Press "Forgotten your password?" link and create a new password via a link sent to you by email.


Returning Visitor

Sign in as a returning visitor: If you created your UKCP account already in the past



2. How to create an account




- Enter your First name and Last name.

3. Changing the grade via your account



4. Changing the grade to: Retired Member


- Before you start your application, get acquainted with the retired membership grade requirements
